JOB SUMMARY: This is supervisory work of a highly technical nature which involves responsibility for developing and implementing network operations policy, program priorities and developing and maintain hardware configuration. This process also includes the installation of all network equipment software. Incumbent will be assigned to provide support services to various departments utilizing the network computer systems within the Government Center. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Information Systems Director. Supervision is exercised over operations personnel. The incumbent does related work as required

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- (a) Possession of a Bachelor's Degree in computer science or related field and two years of supervisory experience in the operation of a computer network; or
- (b) Completion of 60 semester credit hours at a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university, including 12 credits in computer science or electronic data processing, six of which were directly related to the operation of a computer network, and six years experience in the operation of a computer network, two of which must have been in a supervisory capacity; or
- (c) Eight years of experience in the operation of a computer network, two years which must have been in a supervisory capacity; or
  - (d) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of A), B), and C) above.
